LTSpice - A Circuit Analysis **Program**

This free and powerful version of SPICE is one of many modern programs for doing circuit analysis. It features intuitive schematic entry, numerous types of analysis and an active support group on-line. He will show how to get the program from Linear Technology, how to enter a few simple networks and a few of the analysis capabilities.

Jerry was first licensed in 1961 as WNØACF. Most of his operating is on CW. He has also operated on the RS series of satellites, some PSK and 2 meters. His ham radio background prepared him very well for four years in communications in the U.S. Air Force plus eighteen years in the Minnesota Air National Guard. He has a BS in Electrical Engineering from the University of Missouri-Rolla. He has worked for Motorola, E.F. Johnson, and Honeywell as an RF and Analog design engineer.

Again, get there early as the seating is limited!


SIMPLE CALLSIGN LOOKUP
